Create account

To start using Letter Order, you need to create an account, and to do so, you must first determine what type of user you will be. If you are in this section, it means that you are interested in creating an "student" account as mentioned on the main login page of the app.

How to create an account

After downloading and installing the app. When you open the app, you will see the option

6. Tap **OK** and you will now be able to login.



3. Enter the password you have created  **Password** (write it down somewhere or save it in a password manager for your convenience).



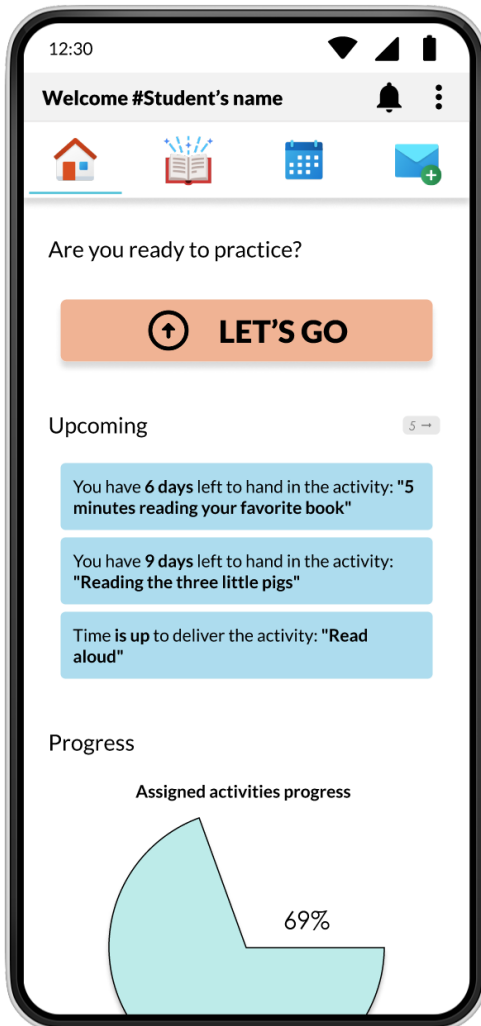

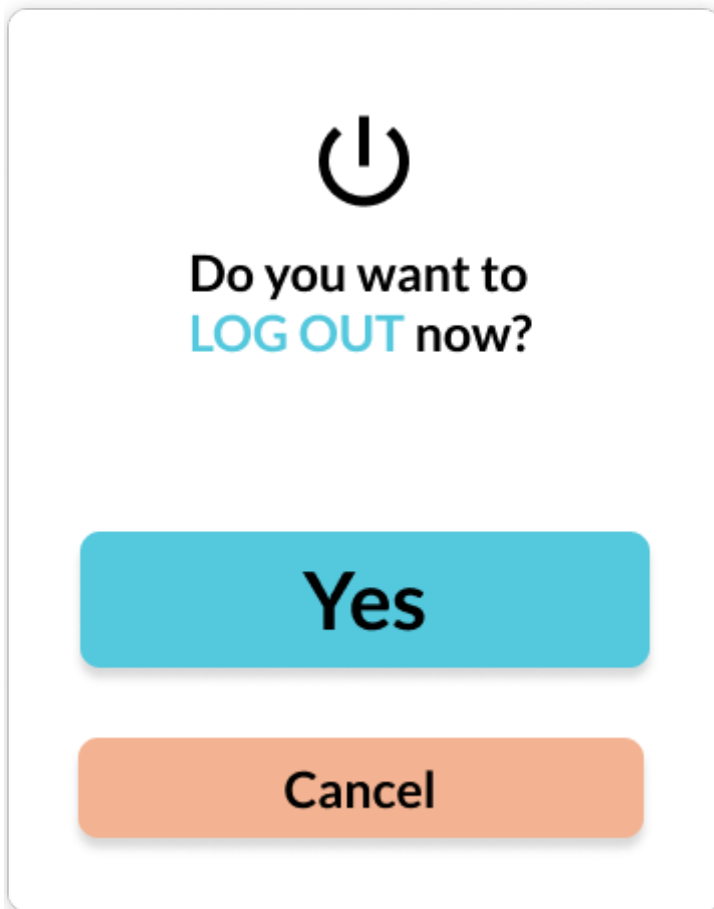

3. In the pop up you have to tap "Yes" if you want to continue or "Cancel" if don't.

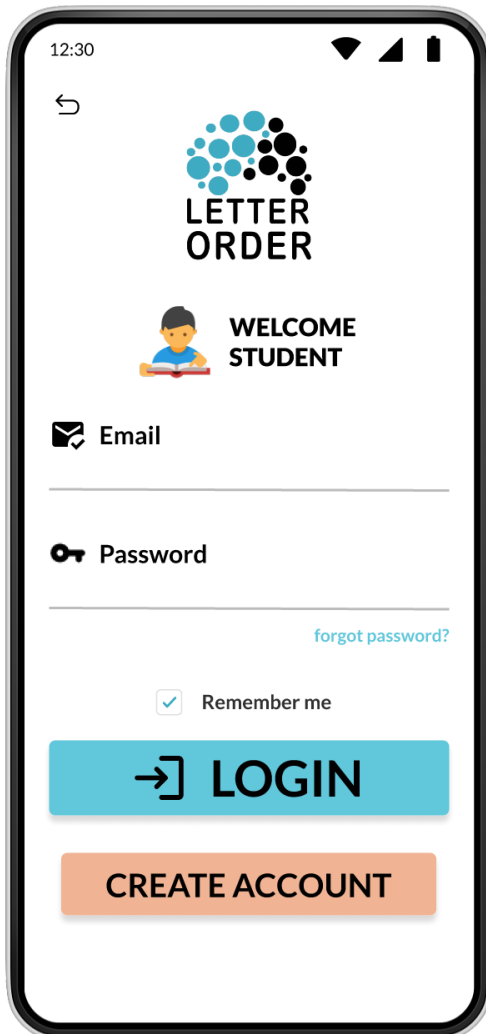


In your profile you can find your information to display as student.

Once there in your profile you will be able to find your information:

- Add or change your profile picture
 1. Tap on your profile picture 
 2. Choose between taking a photo and uploading an image from your files.
 3. Once you have selected the image tap "Done" and your image will be uploaded to your profile.
- Change your password
 1. Tap on the edit icon next to your email and password 
 2. The new window will ask you to enter your current password, a new password and repeat the new password.

 3. Tap  button. The legend "Your password has changed" confirms the change.
- Your student code: which you can share with your teacher and parents so the accounts can be linked and interact.
- Linking: Where you can enter the teacher's code to link their accounts and start interacting.

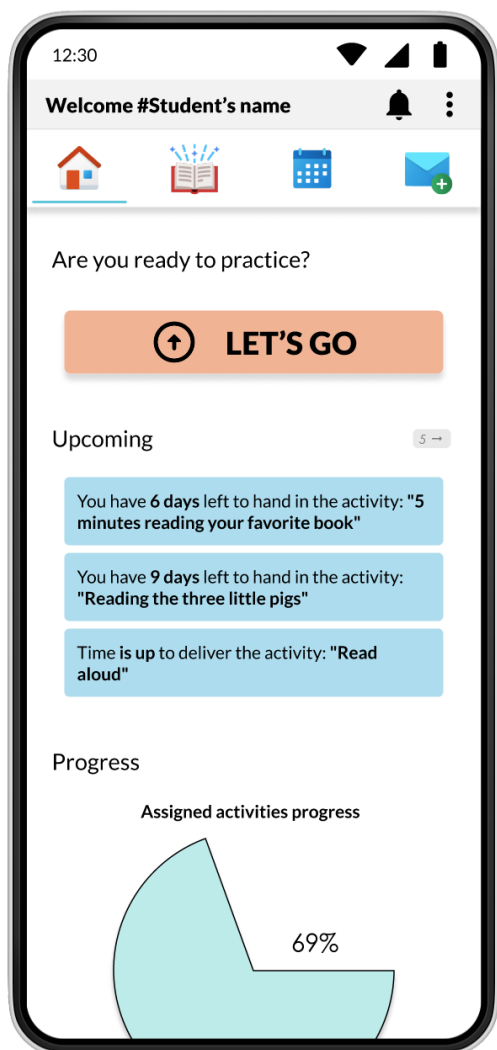


Main functions

Letter Order has features that facilitate the learning process and are useful tools for achieving positive results in the classroom. Students reinforce their reading and writing skills through activities and exercises.

Main menu

When logging in, the main screen will display the main menu, an invitation to practice, followed by a list of pending activities to be performed and below that a graph showing the progress of the assigned activities.



The menu that will be used consists of 4 sections.



Home

The Home screen is displayed when you start the application. It's function is to show recent activities, pending tasks, and the progress of activities. It is the screen that you can refer to when you are in need of an overview of your overall progress.

Activities

In the Activities section, you will find the activities that your teacher has assigned to you as well as practice activities that you can do on your own.

Calendar

In the Calendar section, you can view upcoming meetings. You can add personal reminders and check due dates for activities.

Mensajeria

You can find conversations with teachers, classmates, parents, and groups in the Messages section.

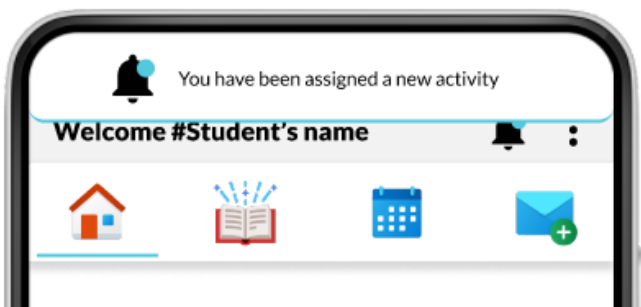
Also in this section, you will have access to the notices that the teacher will post in order to inform you of any important information that does not require a reply.

The activities section is designed to control the flow of assignment, review and feedback of exercises.

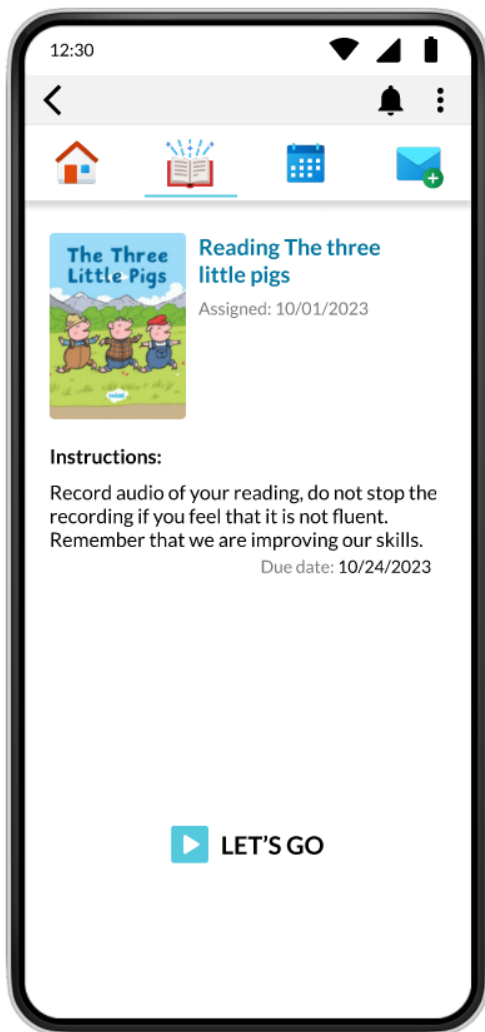
Assigned activities

You will receive a notification when an activity is assigned to you.



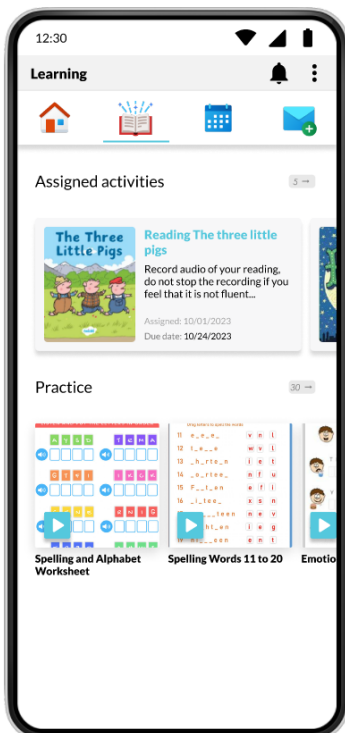
To check which activities are assigned to you:
